Blueprint Reading & Trades Math:

February 26th - March 9th: Tuesday and Thursday nights from 6 - 9pm and Saturdays from 9am - 5pm

This 26-hour introductory training covers basic residential print reading skills, abbreviations, plot plans, foundation plans, floor plans, exterior elevations, section views, details, framing plans, door & window schedules, finish schedules, and specifications. Trades math includes solving with ratio and proportion, fractions, decimals, and the 3-4-5 layout method.

Carpentry:

April 1st—5th: Monday - Friday, 8am - 5pm

This 40-hour introductory training covers the basics of carpentry and trades math. Accurate reading and use of a tape measure, 3-4-5 layout method, and safe use of power tools. Hands-on portion includes building a sawhorse, a foot stool, and a set of stairs to a platform. Construction site education, safety, and carpenter expectations are also covered.

Shielded Metal Arc Welding:

April 23rd - May 4th: Tuesdays & Thursdays from 6pm - 9pm and Saturdays from 9am to 4pm

This 24 hour introductory training covers: vertical and horizontal stick welding, oxygen and acetylene cutting, safe use of hands-on tools and materials, welding practices, identifying joint design, fit-up and electrode selection. Hands-on practice with stick welding.
