Fairbanks General Construction:

February 25th - March 1st; M-F 8am - 4:30pm

Training covers lite version of general construction field assessment, trenching and back filling, sack and patch training and the hazards of silica in construction, hand signal/voice command training for cranes and forklifts and additional training as future construction craft laborers candidates.

Anchorage Construction Driver:

June 3rd - June 14th; M-F 8am - 5pm

Training includes 4 days CDL-A permit preparation and testing and 5 days of hands-on training using a tractor trailer. Successful participants will be scheduled to interview for apprenticeship following training.
