Requirements:

- * Apply online.
- * High School Diploma or GED
- * Must have paid into the Alaska Unemployment insurance in the last 5 years
- * Must bring S.S. Card to first day of class if accepted (U.S. Citizen & Alaskan Resident)
- * Copy of valid Alaska Driver's License for at least 30 days
- * Proof of a minimum one (1) year driver license and copy of valid Alaska Driver's License for at least 30 days with Clean Driving Record for up to the last 5 years.
- * Must be an Alaska Resident for 30 days prior to application and intend to make Alaska your permanent home.
- * Must have original or Certified COPY of Birth Certificate or a current U.S. Passport
- * **Must be able to PASS Drug and Alcohol Screening Test and USDOT Physical to obtain Physical Card**
- * **Must also be able to obtain and pass a Federal background Check - required with acceptance into the Teamsters**
- * **Must meet the Construction Truck Driver Apprenticeship Requirements.**
- * Must be 19 years old by September 9, 2019
- * WorkKeys Test Score of 4 or higher
